High-end retail thriving in Houston

Big-box retail chains have been downsizing on a national level but a number of luxury retailers in Houston are getting larger, reports the Houston Chronicle.

The luxury retail surge — both locally and nationally — means spending on high-end goods may soar this holiday season, retail analysts told the Chronicle.

Indeed, five luxury retailers will have made their Texas debuts by the end of the year, the Chronicle reports. Omega, Hugo Boss and London-based L.K. Bennett are already open, while Miu Miu and Prada will open in the Galleria within the next two weeks.

Meanwhile, South Africa-based De Beers recently picked Houston to launch its Wildflowers Collection diamond line.
