New tower could emerge near Galleria

A new office tower may one day stand in the Galleria area where a health club will soon close, the Houston Chronicle reports.

The tower, which documents show will replace 24 Hour Fitness on Post Oak, may be 30 stories high. The property is owned by TIAA-CREF, a retirement fund provider, according to the Chronicle.

At least two other buildings are already under construction on Post Oak, the Chronicle reports.
